Hat Day: - 30^{th} and 31st January 2019.


Please watch out for an e-mail with details of these events closer to the date.

These lessons will take place daily for each of our Pre KG and KG1 children. Lessons start from 8.05am for some classes so it is very important that the children are in on time please so as not to miss the opportunity of taking part.



Extra Curricula: -

<u>Juventus Football</u> will be returning from Sunday 13th January 2019. The timings will be from 11am. Classes are filling up fast so if you would like your child to participate, please contact the office before Sunday.

Morning arrival time: - For many children the tone of their day is often started



with a smooth and calm arrival at school helping them to establish regular routines and understanding the events for the day. We request that all children are in school no later than 8.15 as arriving late disturbs the classroom activities. Teachers are here to receive the children from 7.30 am. If you are late arriving please take your child to reception to

be taken to class, please no parents are to enter classrooms after 8.15am or before 12.30pm as this can cause a disruption to the activities.

End of day arrangements: - All students to be collected from their classrooms. Please can parents knock and wait for the child to be brought out to them. Collection time for Villa 1, Octopus, Starfish, Jellyfish and Seahorses Classes is 12.30pm. For Villa 2, Turtles, Sharks, Stingrays and Penguins, their collection time is 12.45pm.

<u>Note: -</u> While the end of the day provides a valuable opportunity to get to know other parents and staff we request that all areas are vacated by 1pm. This will avoid any confusion and provide a calm environment for those children who stay until later in the day.



Please make sure we have clear identification of people that can pick your child up from school. We will not release a child without prior arrangements or notification and clear identification of the person collecting your child. Please call the office to notify of any changes.

try and ease the parking so we kindly ask that parents collect their children and leave as soon as they can so that parking spaces are free for the next parents arriving.
